SMALL COMMERCIAL – WINTER TIME OF USE RATE

Availability

This optional rate is available to consumers that require 50 kVA or less of transformer capacity for single- and/or three-phase service for commercial lighting, small power, and other commercial or business uses. The Winter monthly charges are applicable during the months of October through April, and may be selected at the consumer's request. This rate will be effective for the first billing period following the consumer's request for the rate. If the consumer chooses to select a different available rate, the selected rate will be effective for the first billing period following the consumer's request.

Applicability

Not applicable to master metered mobile home parks. Service under this rate shall not be resold or shared with others.

Time Period

Winter: Applies to the months of October through April. The energy charge will vary by the time of day that the energy is used (On-Peak or Off-Peak). On-Peak time period for this rate is 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. All other hours are Off-Peak hours.

Summer: Applies to the months of May through September. The energy charge is based on how much energy (kWh) is used during the month.

Minimum Monthly Charge

The minimum monthly charge shall be the higher of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:



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- (1) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service; or
- (2) The Service Availability Charge.

Tax Adjustment

The Cooperative is authorized to collect and pass on, by adding to the bill to the consumer, the applicable proportionate part of any taxes or government impositions which are or may in the future be assessed on the basis of the gross revenues of the Cooperative and/or the price or revenue from the electric energy or service sold and/or the volume of energy purchased for sale and/or sold hereunder.

Purchased Power Cost Adjustment

The Cooperative shall, if purchased power cost is increased or decreased above or below the base purchased power cost of \$0.066160 per kWh sold, flow through such increases or decreases to all classes of consumers in accordance with NMPRC Rule No. 550.

Meter Readings

All meter readings and billings shall be based on actual meter readings, except due to meter failure or the inability to obtain an actual reading (e.g., inclement weather) when a reasonable estimate of the amount of energy and/or billing demand shall be made by the Cooperative. Meter readings and billings will be made as closely as practical on the same day each month on a cycle basis.

Terms of Payment

Billings made under this rate will be due and payable upon receipt and past due fifteen (15) days from the date the bill is mailed. Service will be subject to disconnect in accordance with the Cooperative's collection policy.

Renewable Energy Rider

The Cooperative shall add to its bill a Renewable Energy Rider in the amount set forth in its separate Rate Rider No. 1.

Other Charges

Other charges may be applicable subject to approval by the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission.


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
